Ranch Riding is a class designed to showcase the movement and versatility of ranch style horses. It will be an individually worked and scored class. It is a great opportunity to offer another show situation to the reining horse and welcomes other riders and gives them an opportunity to compete.

The Ranch Riding class will follow the guidelines and rules of the AQHA Ranch Pleasure/Ranch Riding class. AQHA rules can be reviewed online at www.AQHA.com.

All SRRA Ranch Riding classes will be jackpot classes and eligible for year-end awards. The exception will be the Green Ranch Riding Class that will award the green rider by point accumulation and a buckle awarded upon completion of accrued points stated in the class rules below.

All SRRA club classes are all breed classes.

Membership requirements: You do not have to be an SRRA member to compete in SRRA Club shows, but to be eligible for class prizes and year-end awards a current membership is required. Memberships can be purchased at the show.
