## STALLS/SHAVINGS/RESERVATIONS

Please contact the Ford Idaho Horse Park at [www.fordidahocenter.com](http://www.fordidahocenter.com) or (208) 442-3335 for stall maps and to make all stall reservations. Reservations will open May 4, 2021. Stall rate: \$150/each (Thursday, June 3rd - Sunday, June 6th) collected by FIHP. Single day stall rentals are available for \$35/day through FIHP (all overnight horses must be in a stall). Shavings and pellets must be purchased through FIHP. FIHP does not permit the use of outside shavings or pellets. Local horses not stalled at the FIHP shall pay a \$30/horse haul-in fee (one fee for entire show), payable to the show secretary.

## ARENAS

Move in day is Thursday June 3, 2021. No arenas will be available for use until then.

## PAID WARMUPS

The arena will be open on Thursday (June, 3rd) from 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. for scheduled warmups. Local horses not stalled at the FIHP shall pay a \$30/horse haul-in fee (one fee for entire show), payable to the show secretary.

## NRHA APPROVED CLASSES

All NRHA classes, including aged events and ancillary classes, will be awarding trophies based on NRHA guidelines.  
All NRHA Events will pay-out using NRHA payback schedule A.

## SRRA RANCH RIDING CLASSES

Membership in the SRRA is not required to enter SRRA RR classes at this show.

**"SCHOOLING"** Contestants are expected to run the designated NRHA pattern assigned to the class they are schooling in.

## DRAWS

The office will close from approximately 5:00PM to 6:00PM each day to prepare the draws for the following day. Additional entries will continue to be accepted until 60 minutes before start of the classes however; once drawn, late additions will be the first to show **EXCEPT** for Sunday. Sunday late entries will be the last to show in the class.

Note that NRHA regulations prohibit refunding of entry fees once drawn.

## CONDITIONS

### Lead-line Class

A lead-line class for children aged 7 and under will be held on Saturday after the Limited Non Pro. Riders must be accompanied in the class by an adult who will lead the horse and rider at a walk. No "reining" maneuvers will be performed.

Qualifiers are being offered across the United States and Canada at regional NRHA approved events in 2021. The qualifying classes will run concurrent with NRHA Rookie Level 2 and NRHA Ancillary Non Pro divisions.

**Exhibitors are required to enter into the corresponding NRHA event divisions to be eligible for The Run For A Million (TRFAM) Qualifier.** The top five placings, and ties in each slate, qualify to compete at The Run For A Million, August 17 – 21, 2021, Las Vegas, NV.

Qualification is based on the rider, not the horse, only one time qualification required. See entry terms and conditions for complete entry details. There is a separate entry fee for exhibitors for each qualifying division, per slate; \$200 for Rookie and \$200 for Non Pro. There is no prize money offered and these qualifiers are not NRHA approved, but do fall under the same rules and regulations. The entry fees have been established to ensure those who are committed to wanting to take part in TRFAM Championships have the opportunity to do so without the possibility of being knocked out of a top five spot by another exhibitor who does not wish to, or cannot participate at TRFAM.
